GATE 1 - Creative Spark



ASTROLOGY: Scorpio

TAROT: The Magician

<u>I'CHING:</u> Qian

ENERGY: Pure Masculine, Assertive, Energetic

LOCATION: Heart Center, pointing upward to the throat.

If you let your gaze soften on the bodygraph as you look at gate 1, you will see the astrological sign for Scorpio & the I'Ching Hexagram.

The energy of this gate is the force that wants to bring to life the Divine's creations. The will to act with passion, assertiveness, and uninhibited excitement, like the pop of a champagne bottle. It's forceful, cocksure, and messy, and it brings light to the darkness.

In the I'Ching, this gate is represented by Qian, the Creative, which has six solid (-) lines. The male (yang) energy is represented by a solid line. With all six lines being yang, this gate represents the highest octave of the masculine energy. We were all born with this energy, whether or not it was cosmically activated in our Human Design charts when we were born. This is the energy that you had as a child before you started to absorb external conditioning. You were 100% connected to your heart and to its pulses, that drive your desires to experience, to connect, to seek, and to make things happen.

Fun bites: observe babies. When they want their food, will they ask for permission to want that milk now? Will they strategize on the best way to get that milk? Will they ignore their emotional urges as a result of their empty tummy? No, they will just scream with gusto! And milk comes. Brilliant!

When this gate shows up, you have the energy to manifest your heart's desire, to create, or to bring something to life. In your

awakening, you are remembering that you are a spark of the Divine Source manifesting in human form. That your desire is God's desire for you. Thus, it is your life's purpose to continue unraveling your purpose by following your joy and expressing your creative side. Listen to your heart, follow its inner nudging direction. You have something within you that is unquantifiable and seeking expression out into the world.

As a society we have been conditioned to always be ON. In fact "always on" is now a terminology that is used to show superiority. In the spiritual world, we also have similar expectations, "Always be in High Vibration." What we have forgotten is that as a living being, we evolve. In metamorphosis, a caterpillar transforms into a chrysalis before becoming a butterfly. A Big Bang happens after a Big Crunch. Cells go into entropy before multiplying. And so does your creative spark! Give yourself permission to stay present to where it takes you; the high, the low and anything in between. Stand firm in experiencing it all; and not to escape, because the gift is in being in discomfort.

Light and activated, you are in tune with your creator's side, and follow every pulse that sparks within your heart, even if the ideas seem abstract, their future is unknown, and will make you look like the weirdo in the family. It makes no difference how you express your creation or what type of work you do; it is all about following the inspirations that are given to you through your dreams and imagination and fully trusting in the process. Meditate on the following:

• What does my soul wish to create that adds beauty to the world?

In shadow, you question yours and your Creator's energy. You feel uninspired and unmotivated. You dive into a state of melancholy and anxiety, even to a point of depression. Unconscious you're in this shadow, you turn your back on your Creator. You choose to live a life following other people's expectations of you. And you escape your conundrum by opting into society's forms of cool things to do: substances, binge watching, endless retreating, shopping therapy, taking (too many) personal development courses and many others. If this is where you are now, let's pause for a moment. Shadow is always a great deconditioning portal.

Shadow is a portal to enlightenment. Ask yourself the following:

- Who is judging me right now? And what's his/her (the?) purpose?
- Whose love/approval will I lose if I can be my most creative self?
- Without these stories, who am I?

• What self destructive habits and self limiting beliefs can I release now to follow my soul's wish?

In Human Design, Gate #1 is located in the G-Center reaching up to the throat chakra. This energy is seeking expression, manifestation. Your Creative Spark is wanting to get out into the world! The G-Center is the home of your Higher Self, your soul, love and direction. Your soul, your unquantifiable essence, knows what it wants. Being a directional Gate, this energy is inviting you to follow your heart. Speak the words out loud so as to hear your inner truth, to hear your inner knowing. Metaphorically, in what direction are you headed? Where do you wish to go? What is your soul's destined trajectory?

This Gate is part of the individual circuitry, which is all about discovering what differentiates you from the collective. With this energy, you have something to offer that is remarkably unique to you. No one else has it. It is up to you to take the time to discover what it is that you have to share with the world.

"There is a great difference between one idler and another idler. There is someone who is an idler out of laziness and lack of character, owing to the baseness of his nature. How to embody this energy:

- Observe a baby. Watch his or her energy and how without words/clear language, he/she is able to manifest what his/her desires are.

If there are no words to describe these sparks, go with whatever sound that vibrates from your heart and throat. Who knows? You might actually be speaking in light language!

**In the first look, i-Ching's hexagrams look complicated, but they're not. Look deeper and you'll see that each hexagram is a combination of solid lines; the male (yang) energy, and broken lines (--), the female (yin) energy. Just like the creation of the universe, each gate on Human Design and hexagrams in i-Ching, shows permutation and interactions between the yang and yin energies.



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
